Registration process

1. Complete one registration form per player;
2. Players will be registered with CHESSA;
3. Pay the entry fee at any Standard Bank branch or via internet banking:

5. No telephonic or SMS entries will be accepted;
6. Entries received after closing date and time will participate from the second round and will carry a R50 penalty;
7. Players must bring the original registration document and proof of payment to the tournament;
8. Closing date: 2nd February 2011 @ 21h00

Tournament Arrangements

1. Players will be divided into groups according to their rating;
2. Should any player want to play in a higher level, please contact the organisers at the registration desk for assistance;
3. The beginners division are for players not yet rated or with a rating less than 800;
4. It is the responsibility of each player to ensure that he/she is entered into the correct section;
5. The following tiebreak system (in the order as given) will be used: 1) Tournament Performance; 2) Cumulative; 3) Solkov; 4) Sonneborn-Berger and no more than one prize will be awarded to any one player and will not be shared;
6. Prizes must be claimed on the day at the venue during the prize giving ceremony; (unclaimed prizes will be forfeited);
7. Prize giving will be held after the last round;
8. Right of admission reserved;
9. No item may be sold or traded by any person other than those given permission by the tournament organizer in writing;
10. By your entry into this tournament you hereby agree unconditionally to abide by all the rules and regulations;
11. FIDE Rules apply;
12. The organizers of the tournament are not responsible for the safety of players or their property;
13. Players must provide their own chess pieces and clocks. The organisers will provide the chess boards. Pieces will be provided for the Beginners Section, Clocks not required for the Beginners Section;
