<ol style="list-style-type: none"> Players will be allowed to enter in a higher section; The organisers reserve the right to merge or change division of the sections on the grounds of availability of space and the size of the sections; The first 130 entries will be accepted; Right of admission reserved; No items may be sold or traded by any person other than those given permission by the tournament organizer in writing; By your entry into this tournament you agree unconditionally to abide by all the rules and regulations; The organizers of the tournament are not responsible for the safety of players or their property; Players have to provide their own chess pieces and clocks. The organisers will provide the chess boards. Players who do not have clocks are also welcome to participate; FIDE rules apply; Brilliant Tuck shop will be available.
